

Terms and Conditions



Booking and payment

1. The student must give correct information and documents when they make their application to MDA College. If a student gives false or doctored information on their application, MDA College has the right to cancel that booking at any time. The student will receive no refund.
2. Students cannot hold their place on any MDA College course until they have returned the final page of their Letter of Acceptance (their Offer Acceptance Form) and paid the full deposit of 20%. A student who does not do these may lose their place on the course.
3. MDA College will make an offer to the student based on the courses and routes available. Students will be told if their first choice course/route is not available and will be offered another suitable course if possible. Please see our policies for more information on this.
4. MDA College will make an offer to the student based on their qualifications and their university choices. Students who do not meet the entry requirements for a course may be offered an alternative course if possible.
5. By accepting a place on an MDA College course, the student agrees to pay for the course in full. Students can make a Payment Plan with MDA College if they want to pay in instalments. Students who do not complete payments may lose their place at MDA College.
6. Students can cancel their place at MDA College without any penalties within 14 days of returning their Offer Acceptance Form. However, the deposit of 20% is non-refundable unless in extreme circumstances. Please see our policies for more information or email info@mdacollege.com if you have more questions.
7. MDA College will only offer a place on a course when all the application documents have been sent to us.
8. All acceptance decisions are made by MDA College management. MDA management make their decision by looking at a student's application forms and documents and deciding if that student will be able to complete the course. Their decisions are not changed by the nationality, gender, age, sexuality or any other personal information.
